ORDER

As per the Government order read as second paper above, orders have been issued approving the seat details including the number of seats to be increased for implementing reservation for Economically Weaker Sections for admission to Pharmacy/Paramedical Degree courses.

2) As per the Circular read as first paper above, the Pharmacy Council of India clarified that to implement reservation for Economically Weaker Sections, 10% of "Approved intake" will be considered by the Council i.e. the enhancement for EWS quota has to be done institution wise. As per letter read as third paper above, the Director of Medical Education submitted a revised proposal accordingly.

3) Government have examined the proposal in detail and are pleased to accord sanction to increase seats to implement EWS Reservation for Pharmacy/Para Medical Degree Courses, as detailed below, from the academic year 2020-21, without any additional financial commitment involved, subject to affiliation by Kerala University of Health

Sciences/Pharmacy Council of India.
